

Learn the fundamental skills of becoming a good pilot. Our Private Pilot Course teaches FAA Regulations, basic radio techniques, use of checklists, aircraft control, aircraft orientation and navigation using outside references, airspace, aircraft systems and weight and balance. Our Private Pilot Course has three phases:

PHASE 1: Pre-Solo

Most of your Private Pilot Training is spent in Phase 1. Here you learn all the fundamental skills of flying as well as the maneuvers required by the FAA in order to solo.

PHASE 2: Cross-Country

Once you have completed your solo flight, you are ready to learn how to conduct a cross country flight. Three solo cross country flights are required.

PHASE 3: Checkride Preparation

Your instructor will help you prepare for your checkride by conducting a mock oral exam.

You will also review and practice the flying maneuvers required by the FAA.

The Private Pilot Course schedule is flexible and can be completed in as little as 6-8 weeks of dedicated training. Most clients complete the course in approximately 70 hours of flight time. We can also provide training on a daily or weekly schedule with a course designed to fit your needs.
